Bridget Zimmermann

BRIDGET ZIMMERMANN has been the general music teacher at Barretts Elementary in the Parkway School District in St. Louis, MO since 1999. Mrs. Zimmermann graduated from Truman State University with a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Vocal Music and a Master of Arts in Education (M.A.E.). Mrs. Zimmermann has performed as a member of the Robert Shaw Chorale and previously directed choral ensembles at Washington University. Mrs. Zimmermann was a director of the Kirkwood Children's Chorale for 10 years and directed the choirs abroad in England, Hawaii, and China. She holds Level I and II certification in the Orff Approach and has studied choral conducting with internationally known conductor and teacher, Mr. Henry Leck. Mrs. Zimmermann is also certified in World Music Drumming Level I and has studied jazz with international clinician, Doug Goodkin.

Mrs. Zimmermann is the past-president of the St. Louis American Orff Schulwerk Association and chaired the Children's Performances Committee for the National AOSA Conference in St. Louis in 2012. She is a member of the American Orff Schulwerk Association, St. Louis American Orff Schulwerk Association, Missouri Music Educators Association, and NAFME--the National Association for Music Education. Mrs. Zimmermann was selected as the Barretts Teacher of the Year in 2004. In 2013 she was named a quarterfinalist for the first-ever Grammy Educator award. Mrs. Zimmermann received National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Certification in Music Early/Middle Childhood in 2013.

Angie Kelton has worked for the Mehlville School District (St. Louis, MO) as a traveling K-5 general music teacher for the past 9 years. She typically travels between 3-4 schools during any given year and has worked at 7 of the 10 elementary schools in her district at one time or another. Mrs. Kelton graduated from Illinois State University with a Bachelors in Music Education (BME) and she holds Level I Orff Certification. She is currently working on a Masters in Educational Technology (MET) at Webster University in St. Louis.

Mrs. Kelton has presented workshops for the Mehlville School District, St. Louis Chapter of AOSA, and Illinois Music Educators Association. She served as the local conference committee chair for Signs & Certificates at the AOSA National Conference in 2012. Mrs. Kelton has served as the St. Louis AOSA Chapter's webmaster since 2009. 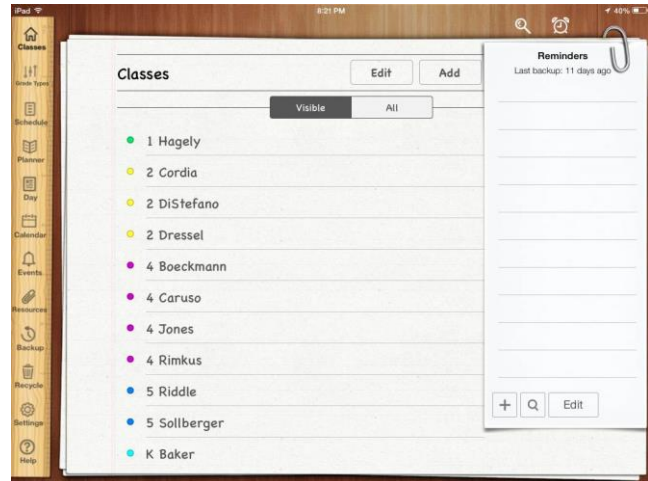

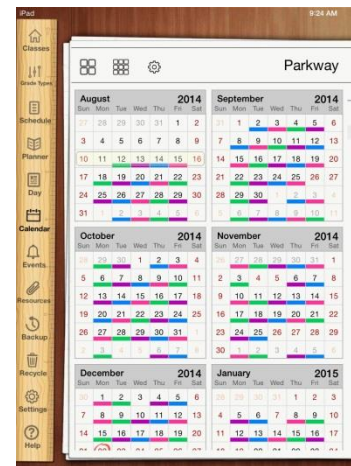
CLASS LIST

- Specialize schedule for certain days (early release, late start, etc.)



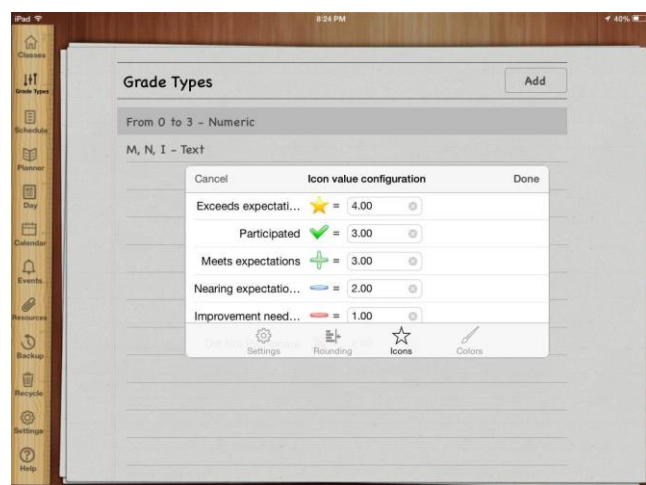
SCHEDULE

- Configure your own grades, either with text, numbers, icons, or a combination of them all



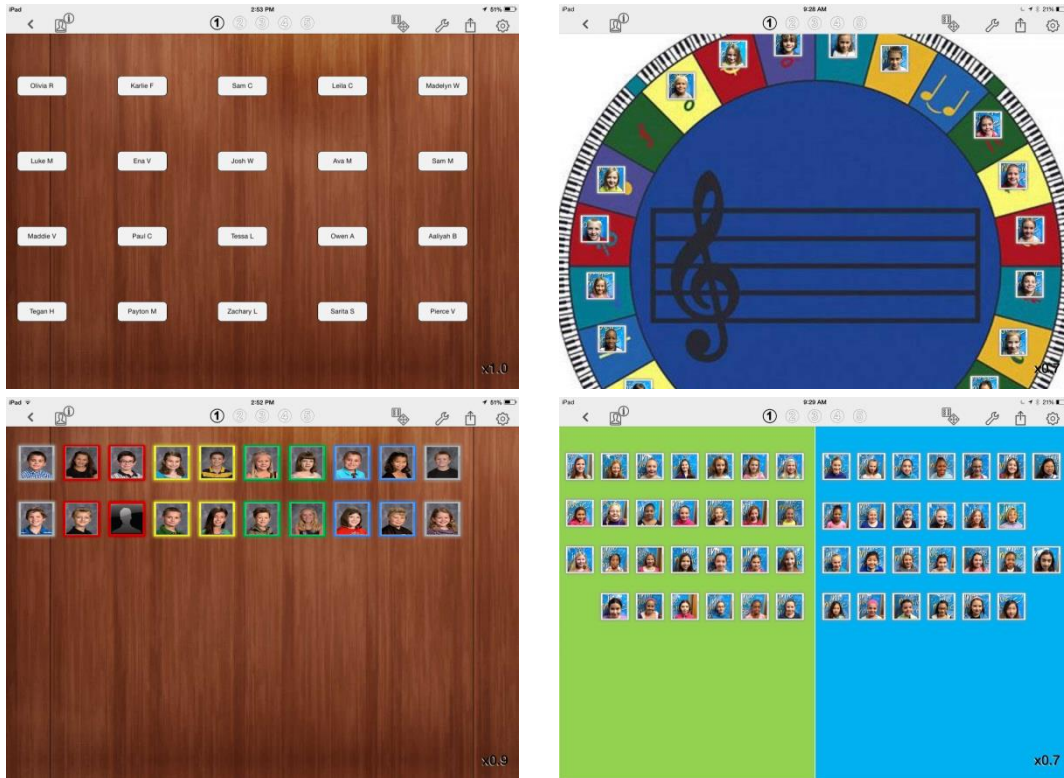

- Add new students individually or import from a CSV or XLS file
- Sort students by first name or last name
- Add detailed contact information to each student, if desired
- Include student photos, audio, and video files
- Create columns for assignments & customize name, date given, column width, column color, type of grade input, type of grade output
- Use text, numbers, colors, or icons to input & represent grades
- Assign detailed annotations (comments) for each student and each grade given
- Average specific columns for cumulative assignments & end of term grades
- Create separate tabs for multiple gradebooks in each class (term/semester, special assignments, behavior, recorder, etc.)
- Import grades from one tab to another tab within the same class or to another class

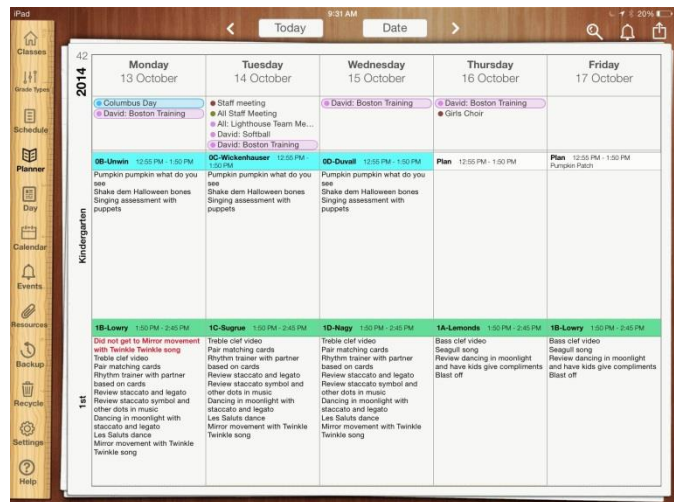
SEATING CHART



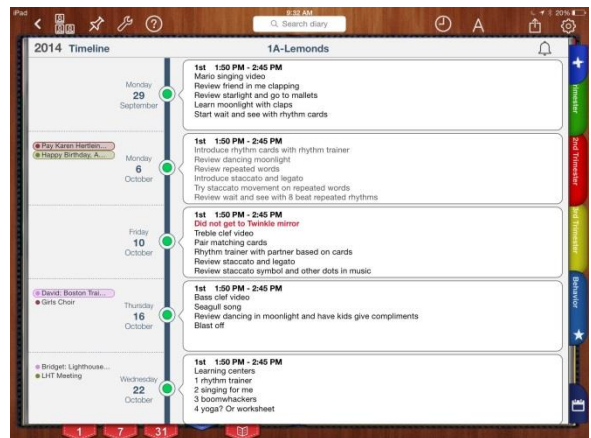
- Up to 5 different seating charts for each class
- Option to add student pictures (import or take pictures through the app using the iPad camera)
- Student pictures linked to gradebook - can enter grades directly from seating chart
- Zoom or pan to see all students
- Color-code students based on seating, ability level, etc.
- Random student selector (dice)
- Ability to randomize seating plan (great for creating new seating charts later in the year)
- Ability to reset by 2s or 3s (great for partners and small groups)
- Seating charts can be exported as PDF's - can print out and leave for sub

PLANNER

- Digital planner displayed like a traditional paper planner
- Must have schedule set up in order to use - each section in planner is attached to a class or class period
- Add calendar events to the planner - automatically connects to iCal calendar app
- Able to copy and paste plans from one class to another



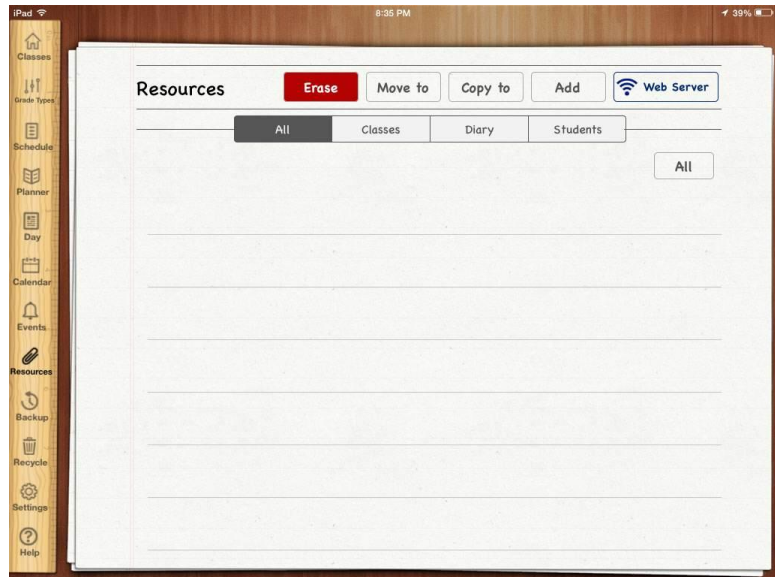
DIARY



- Only accessible through the gradebook (tabs along bottom)
- Connects to planner - does everything the planner does, but allows you to focus on the sequence of one class at a time
- Add notes for each day of class - lesson plans, reminder notes, reflections on outcome of lesson, etc.
- Daily, weekly, monthly, sequence and planner views

RESOURCES

- Ability to attach files to class, student, gradebook column, and/or gradebook cell
- Files can include photos, audio clips, videos, PDF's, URL links, etc.
- Files can be inserted from the Resources tab, but also from within the gradebook itself



BULLETIN BOARD

- Digital bulletin board
- Only accessible through the gradebook (little thumb tack icon)
- Useful to visually organize class resources
