



MMEA Mentoring Chair

POSITION SUMMARY: The MMEA Mentoring Chair shall assist in all matters pertaining to mentoring young music teachers in the state of Missouri.

Position Responsibilities:

- Secure and coordinate one (1) clinic session for the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference
- Preside over the Mentoring Clinic at the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference.
- Maintain the New Teacher Resource page on the MMEA web site.
- Attend MMEA Board of Director Meetings (February, May, August)
- Submit four articles for the Missouri School Music Magazine (February, April, August, November)

Qualifications:

- Candidates for MMEA Mentoring Chair must hold certification from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education in Instrumental or Vocal Music Education.
- The MMEA Mentoring Chair must have served in the field of music education for a minimum of fifteen (15) years.
- The MMEA Mentoring Chair must be a member, in good standing, of MMEA and NAfME.

Terms of Position:

- The MMEA Mentoring Chair is a member of the MMEA Advisory Council.
- MMEA Advisory Council Members are appointed by the MMEA President and approved by the MMEA Board of Directors.
- MMEA Advisory Council Members serve two-year terms coinciding with the MMEA Board of Directors' term.
- MMEA Advisory Council Members serve as non-voting members of the MMEA Board of Directors

Compensation:

- Mileage for meetings in May and August.
