POSITION SUMMARY: The NAfME-C President, annually nominated and elected by NAfME-C membership, shall assist in all matters pertaining to NAfME-C, working closely with the MMEA NAfME-C Coordinator.

Position Responsibilities:

- Work with the MMEA NAfME-C Coordinator to secure and coordinate two (2) clinic sessions, one (1) business meeting and one (1) reception for the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference.
- Preside over NAfME-C clinics at the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference
- Attend MMEA Board of Director Meetings (May, August)
- Submit four articles for the Missouri School Music Magazine (February, April, August, November)

Qualifications:

- Candidates for MMEA NAfME-C President must be currently enrolled as an undergraduate Music Education Major during their term of office.
- The MMEA NAfME-C President must be a member, in good standing, of NAfME-C.
- The MMEA NAfME-C President must be a member in good standing with a NAfME-C recognized chapter at a four year College/University in Missouri.

Terms of Position:

- The MMEA NAfME-C President is a member of the MMEA Advisory Council.
- MMEA Advisory Council Members serve two-year terms coinciding with the MMEA Board of Directors' term.
- MMEA Advisory Council Members serve as non-voting members of the MMEA Board of Directors

Compensation:

- Mileage for meetings in May and August.
