POSITION SUMMARY: The MMEA Technology Chair shall assist in all matters pertaining to the use of technology as it serves music education.

Position Responsibilities:

- Secure and coordinate two (2) clinic sessions Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference.
- Administer all aspects of the Technology Resource Center for the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference
- Preside over Technology Clinics and the Technology Resource Center at the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference
- Attend MMEA Board of Director Meetings (February, May, August)
- Submit four articles for the Missouri School Music Magazine (February, April, August, November)

Qualifications:

- Candidates for Technology Chair must be knowledgeable of effective and proven technological resources that will enhance the music education experience for all students and assist teachers with administrative tasks.
- The Technology Chair must have served in the field of music education for a minimum of five (5) years.
- The Technology Chair must be a member, in good standing, of MMEA and NAfME.

Terms of Position:

- The Technology Chair is a member of the MMEA Advisory Council.
- MMEA Advisory Council Members are appointed by the MMEA President and approved by the MMEA Board of Directors.
- MMEA Advisory Council Members serve two-year terms coinciding with the MMEA Board of Directors' term.
- MMEA Advisory Council Members serve as non-voting members of the MMEA Board of Directors

Compensation:

- Mileage for meetings in February, May and August.
