



MMEA Vice-President: Jazz

POSITION SUMMARY: The MMEA Jazz Vice President will oversee all aspects pertaining to Jazz presentations at the annual Missouri Music Educators Association In-Service Workshop/Conference.

Position Responsibilities:

- Attend MMEA Board of Director Meetings (February, April, August)
- Coordinate the selection process for three (3**) performing ensembles (Jazz) for the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference
- Represent all levels of instrumental and vocal Jazz throughout the state.
- Secure and coordinate three (3**) clinic sessions for the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference.
- Select Outstanding Music Educator and Outstanding Young Music Educator Award.
- Preside over all Jazz concerts and clinics at the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference.
- Submit four articles for the Missouri School Music Magazine (February, April, August, November)
- Serve on MMEA officer recommendation committee. (odd numbered years)

Qualifications:

- Candidates for Jazz Vice President must hold current certification from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education in Instrumental Music Education.
- Candidates for Jazz Vice President must be under a teaching contact during the tenure of their two year term.
- The Jazz Vice President must have served in the field of music education for a minimum of ten (10) years.
- The Jazz Vice President must be a member, in good standing, of MMEA and NAFME.

Terms of Position:

- The MMEA Jazz Vice President is elected by the membership.
- The MMEA Jazz Vice President will serve a two year term beginning in January of the even year.
- The MMEA Jazz Vice President is a voting member of the MMEA Board of Directors.

Compensation:

- Annual In-Service Workshop/Conference lodging.
- Mileage for meetings in February, April and August.
