



MMEA Vice President: College/University

POSITION SUMMARY: The MMEA College/University Vice President will oversee all aspects pertaining to College/University small ensemble/clinic presentations and the All-Collegiate Ensemble at the annual Missouri Music Educators Association In-Service Workshop/Conference.

Position Responsibilities:

- Attend MMEA Board of Director Meetings (February, April, August)
- Secure and coordinate two (2) clinic sessions for the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference
- Preside over all College/University small ensembles and clinics at the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference.
- Select Outstanding Music Educator and Outstanding Young Music Educator Award.
- Submit four articles for the Missouri School Music Magazine (February, April, August, November)
- Manage annual All-Collegiate Ensemble (See four year rotation)
- Serve on MMEA officer recommendation committee. (odd numbered years)

Qualifications:

- Candidates for College/University Vice President must have completed a degree in Music (Masters level or higher).
- Candidates for College/University Vice President must be under a teaching contact at a Missouri two or four year institution during the tenure of their two year term.
- The College/University Vice President must have served in the field of music education for a minimum of ten (10) years.
- The College/University Vice President must be a member, in good standing, of MMEA and NAFME.

Terms of Position:

- The MMEA College/University Vice President is elected by the membership.
- The MMEA College/University Vice President will serve a two year term beginning in January of the even year.
- The MMEA College/University Vice President is a voting member of the MMEA Board of Directors.

Compensation:

- Annual In-Service Workshop/Conference lodging.
- Mileage for meetings in February, April and August.
