

MMEA District Presidents

POSITION SUMMARY: The MMEA District Presidents is responsible for aspects of governing and representing all levels and all disciplines of Music Education within each designated MMEA District.

Position Responsibilities:

- Preside over and govern all aspects of MMEA District music activities.
- Acquire a District Board in accordance with MMEA guidelines to assist and coordinate all aspects of each MMEA District.
- Attend MMEA Board of Director Meetings. (April, August)
- Preside over the designated District meeting at the Annual MMEA In-Service Workshop/Conference.
- Submit two articles for the Missouri School Music Magazine. (February, August)
- Submit at least one nominee each for the MMEA Outstanding Educator and Outstanding Young Educator award.
- Actively report deceased colleagues (current and retired) from your district to the Retired Members Chair for recognition in the Missouri School Music Magazine.

Qualifications:

- Candidates for District President must hold current certification from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education in Instrumental or Vocal Music Education.
- Candidates for District President must be under a teaching contact during the tenure of their two-year term.
- The District President must have served in the field of music education for a minimum of eight (8) years.
- The District President must be a member, in good standing, of MMEA and NAfME.

Terms of Position:

- The MMEA District President is elected by the membership of the eleven (11) individual Districts.
- The MMEA District President will serve a two-year term.
- The MMEA District President is a voting member of the MMEA Board of Directors.

Compensation:

• Mileage for meetings in April and August.
