No credit will be granted for attendance below the required attendance requirement for any reason.

MMEA Conference Session Project Summary of Activities. You are required to complete and submit a summary of activities using the MMEA Session Template. You will use this session to document your attendance, participation and synthesis of conference content. You will be using information to plan and evaluate your professional development. This will be sent to you via email upon your enrollment in the course.

Your grade will be based upon a rubric in five areas: Organization, Conference Sessions, Session Content, Resources and Professional Learning. The Session Content and Professional Learning Categories will be double weighted, and this will result in a score with a total of 21 points possible.

Submission Deadline. The Summary of Activities must be submitted no later than February 19. No late work will be accepted.
